

Paul Ducheyne is Professor of Bioengineering and Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery Research at the University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, USA. He is the Director of its Center for Bioactive Materials and Tissue Engineering. He also is Special Guest Professor at the University of Leuven, Belgium, where he obtained his Materials Science and Engineering degrees.

Paul Ducheyne has lectured around the world and currently serves, or has served on, the editorial board of more than ten scientific journals in the biomaterials, bioceramics, bioengineering, tissue engineering, orthopaedics and dental fields. He has authored about 330 papers and chapters, and he has edited 16 books and book volumes. His papers have been cited more than 10,000 times with an “h-factor” of 58; his ten most visible papers have been cited more than 2,600 times. He is Editor-in Chief of Comprehensive Biomaterials, a 6-volume, 3,650-page major reference work published by Elsevier in August 2011.

Paul Ducheyne has been Secretary of the European Society for Biomaterials, is Past President of the Society for Biomaterials (USA) and Past President of the International Society for Ceramics in Medicine. Among other recognitions, he is a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS), he was the first Nanyang Visiting Professor at the Nanyang Institute of Technology, Singapore and he has received the C. William Hall Award and the Founders Award from the Society for Biomaterials.
